



Accommodations and Online Forms

Some accommodations are associated with specific forms. Each student can only receive one of the following specific forms. This list indicates which version a student will get if more than one accommodation is assigned. The accommodation listed higher on this list determines which form a student receives. For example, if a student taking the ELA/L test is assigned both Text-to-Speech with Graphics ELA and Human Reader – English, the student will receive the Human Reader online accommodation and will not receive Text-to-Speech. The Text-to-Speech accommodation ranks lower than Human Reader – English on the list and will be ignored.

This is the hierarchy that controls which test version a student will receive based on their accommodations:

ELA/Literacy

1. Paper - English
2. Large Print
3. Braille with Tactile Graphics
4. Human Reader - English
5. Sign Language – American Sign Language
6. Text-to-Speech with Graphics ELA
7. Human Signer – Complete Test
8. Assistive Technology – Screen Reader
9. Assistive Technology – Non-Screen Reader
