

What You'll Find in Family Portal

The Family Portal provides access to your child's performance on the Illinois Assessment of Readiness and Illinois Science Assessment tests.

Family Portal Device Response and Additional Languages

Family Portal was designed to be fully scalable with a range of devices, including laptops, tablets, and smartphones. The portal is also available in six additional languages: Arabic, Polish, Russian, Spanish, Ukrainian, and Urdu.

Scale Scores, Proficiency Levels, and How to Interpret Them

Scale scores and performance levels will be displayed on the portal user interface for each test and access to a guide for interpreting these scores is available for download under the Guardian Resources link.

Personalized Video Results

A personalized video illustrating your child's performance on the English Language Arts/Literacy, Mathematics, and/or Science test(s) is included in the Family Portal for viewing.

Full Reports for Downloading

You will be able to download full reports of your child's results for each test taken this year as well as full reports from previous years.

Logging into Family Portal

What You'll Need

- State Student Indentification Number (SSID)
- Family Portal URL: https://familyportal.pearson.com/il

Obtain your child's state student identification number (SSID) from your school. This will be a nine-digit number assigned to your child by the state. This number follows your child in the state's Student Identification System (SIS) while they are enrolled in Illinois public schools.




Family Portal Home Screen



Scale Score and Proficiency Level Overview

The Illinois State Board of Education measures student performance at four levels of proficiency: Above Proficient, Proficient, Approaching Proficient, and Below Proficient. These levels of proficiency correlate with state-adopted scale scores that determine at which level a student's test result will be reported

In this example, a Grade 8 student has achieved an Above Proficient performance level with a scale score of 790. Above Proficient begins at scale score 750. The student performed in the 60th percentile, outperforming year-over year expected progress.




