No changes to shipping and returning test materials

 Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) – return scorable and non-scorable paper materials

 Illinois Science Assessment (ISA) – return non-scorable paper materials





- Access the Test Coordinator Manual on the *Illinois Support Page*.
- Detailed information regarding the return of paper materials can be found in the Test Coordinator Manual starting on page 35.




- Return all secure IAR and ISA paper materials to Pearson after testing (including non-scorable secure materials).
- For IAR materials only:
 - Label completed or partially completed scorable documents as "Scorable".
 - Transcribe large print and braille documents into scannable documents using the regular Grade 3 test book or Grades 4-8 answer documents.
 - Label any documents that may have been started but should not be scored as "Do Not Score".



- Return all scorable and non-scorable paper materials within one week after testing and no later than the following date for each assessment:
 - IAR April 11, 2025
 - ISA May 7, 2025
- Include all test books and scorable answer documents
- Return or destroy scratch paper used during testing
- Do not return manuals or math tools



 If scorable or non-scorable items are lost or misplaced, the School Test Coordinator must complete the Form to Report Contaminated, Damaged or Missing Materials.
